- ALL WORK AND MATERIALS SHALL CONFORM TO THESE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, THE IMPERIAL COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS STANDARDS AND ENCROACHMENT PERMIT CONDITIONS, ANY REFERENCED STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND THE SPECIFICATIONS & THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE AGENCIES REFERRED TO HEREIN. - IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ADHERE FULLY WITH THE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY STORM WATER PERMIT FROM THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY. - BY THE CONTRACTOR, SHOULD ANY SUCH MONUMENTS OR BENCHMARKS BE REMOVED, DAMAGED. OBLITERATED OR ALTERED BY THE CONTRACTORS OPERATIONS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROPER RESETTING OF THE SAME AS PER THE SUBDIVISION MAP ACT, THE PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYORS ACT AND THE SATISFACTION OF THE COUNTY SURVEYOR/DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS. SUCH POINTS SHALL BE REFERENCED AND REPLACED WITH APPROPRIATE MONUMENTATION BY A LICENSED LAND SURVEYOR OR A REGISTERED CIVIL ENGINEER AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE LAND SURVEYING. SEE CAMUTCD FIGURES 3A-101 (CA) THROUGH FIGURE 3A-113 (CA) FOR STRIPING DETAILS. SEE FIGURE 3B-23 FOR PAVEMENT MARKINGS. SEE FIGURE 3B-103 FOR TYPICAL LIMIT LINE
- ALL SIGNING AND RAISED PAVEMENT MARKERS SHALL CONFORM TO THE LATEST EDITION OF THE CALIFORNIA MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (CAMUTCD), AND CALTRANS STANDARD PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INSTALL BLUE RAISED PAVEMENT MARKERS ADJACENT TO ALL FIRE HYDRANT WITHIN THE PROJECT LIMITS IN ACCORDANCE TO THE CAMUTCD.
- ALL TRAFFIC STRIPES, ARROWS AND PAVEMENT MARKINGS SHALL BE PAINT, AND INSTALLED WITH TWO (2) COATS OF PAINT. THE SECOND COAT OF PAINT SHALL BE APPLIED BETWEEN 7 AND 14 DAYS AFTER THE FIRST COAT.
- ALL NEW STRIPING SHALL BE CAT TRACKED AND APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER PRIOR TO PAINTING.
- PRIOR TO FINAL ACCEPTANCE OF STREET IMPROVEMENTS, ALL STREET STRIPING AND STENCILING WITHIN THE PERIMETER OF THE CONSTRUCTION AREA WILL BE RESTORED TO LIKE NEW CONDITION, IN A MANNER MEETING THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNTY OF IMPERIAL.
- CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE CONFLICTING TRAFFIC STRIPES AND PAVEMENT MARKINGS BY WET SANDBLASTING. CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE CONFLICTING PAVEMENT MARKERS. BLACK TAPE MARKING OR GRINDING SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED.
- ALL SIGNS SHALL BE ALUMINUM WITH 3M DIAMOND GRADE RETRO-REFLECTIVE. GUIDE SIGNS SHALL BE ENGINEERING GRADE RETRO-REFLECTIVE FACE.
- SIGNS SHALL BE STANDARD SIZE, UNLESS IN RURAL AREAS OR NOTED OTHERWISE. PRIOR TO INSTALLATION, CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE SHOP DRAWINGS TO THE ENGINEER FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL PRIOR TO ORDERING. EXACT LOCATION OF SIGNS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE
- 0. SIGN POSTS SHALL BE TELESPAR POST IN ACCORDANCE TO IMPERIAL COUNTY STANDARDS, UNLESS APPROVED OTHERWISE BY THE ENGINEER.

- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT DIG ALERT AT 811 AND VERIFY THE EXISTENCE AND LOCATION OF ALL UTILITIES BEFORE COMMENCING WORK.
- DUST SHALL BE CONTROLLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPROVED PM10 PLAN. APPROVAL SHALL BE BY IMPERIAL COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT.
- NO OBSTRUCTION OF FLOOD PLAINS OR NATURAL WATER COURSES WILL BE PERMITTED
- ALL EXISTING DRAINAGE COURSES ON THE PROJECT SITE MUST CONTINUE TO FUNCTION DURING STORM CONDITIONS.
