The following items are considered to be Addendum 1 to the REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE PICACHO SOLID WASTE SITE CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS IN IMPERIAL COUNTY; COUNTY PROJECT NO. 4547SW The following changes shall become part of the agreement documents for this project and all other conditions shall remain the same:

1	<p>Question: 1. Section 2.4 of the FCPCMP states that "CIDPW is currently working on submitting a Notice of Intent (NOI) under the Multi-Section General Permit and developing a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) and Stormwater Monitoring Plan (SWMP) for the PCFS". Has this been completed and if so, are the documents available?</p> <p>Answer: The information on the NOI and Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan is not current. The contractor is expected to complete and submit the SWPPP for the project at the time of construction.</p>
2	<p>Question: 2. Based on text in Federal Register, there appears to be mitigation measures in place for the project (e.g., bio survey, cultural resources). Are there any additional NEPA requirements for the project?</p> <p>Answer: EPA determined that their SSFR Rulemaking process is functionally equivalent to NEPA requirements and a separate EA was not required.</p>
