ADDENDUM NO. 1

DECEMBER 11, 2023

This *ADDENDUM* is hereby made part of the Contract Documents and specifications to the same extent as if originally included therein, and shall be signed by the Respondent and included with the proposal.

Question 1: Please confirm if soil/sand removal is required in preparation for the proposed areas to receive sod. Is there a specified depth of soil that needs to be removed prior to the sod installation?

Response: Please refer to Project Manual, Technical Specifications, Section 801-2.3.

Question 2: If soil removal is required, please confirm the address of the location we need to dump the material. Also please confirm that the contractor will not be responsible for any dump fees.

Response: Contractor is responsible for the dump of materials, location, and fees.

Question 3: Please clarify what specific maintenance tasks are required during the 90-day Landscape maintenance period, and also the frequency of service the County is requiring (weekly, bi-weekly, monthly, etc.).

Response: Please refer to Project Manual, Technical Specifications, Section 801-6.

Question 4: Is this project subject to a PLA (Project Labor Agreement), a PSA (Project Stabilization Agreement), a CBA (Collective Bargaining Agreement), a CWA (Community Workforce Agreement), or anything of that nature?

Response: Please refer to the Project Manual, Public Wors Reforms (SB 854) Fact Sheet.

Question 5: Will the contractor coordinate the water supply? Will these fees be paid by the contractor?

Response: Yes, the contractor is responsible for making the necessary arrangements for the water supply with the Salton Community Service’s District and for any expenses incurred.

Question 6: Will the park be closed for the 90-day maintenance period?

Response: No. Park will remain open as scheduled.

Question 7: How much soil needs to be removed from the field?

Response: Please refer to Project Manual, Technical Specifications, Section 801-2.3

Question 8: **Do we need to export the Soil that was removed?**

Response: Yes, is the contractor's responsibility to coordinate the soil exportation from the job site.


Question 9: **Will the new clock be placed where the old clock is?**
