This Capacity Fee is calculated based on the total amount of gallons of water use per day projected by the County for the project requesting a water meter.

**The initial Water and Sewer Capacity Fees were established to commence on July 1, 2002; and are increased on July 1 of each year, based upon the Engineering News Record Building Cost Index (BCI) available for the nearest California Metropolitan Area.**
