G. Heber Avenue and Correll Road

Mr. Olmedo stated that the Department continues to work on “No Parking” area for the southwest corner of the intersection. Mr. Olmedo added that the Department was also exploring the idea of turning the intersection into a 3-Way Stop Controlled intersection.

IV. New Business

A. Traffic concerns from Law Enforcement Agencies

Mr. Ruedas stated that southbound traffic on Menvielle Road, Maggio Road, and SR-7 continues to be an issue as CHP does not have the resources to sustain surveillance in the area. CHP has closed Maggio Road to force southbound traffic onto SR-7; however, Mr. Ruedas asked if the Department of Public Works would consider a total closure of Menvielle Road between Thursdays through Sunday.

B. Traffic concerns from Engineering Agencies

Mr. Olmedo reported that trucks have been parking along Black Hills Road in Heber, and the Department of Public Works is working on placing “No Truck Parking” signs to get vehicles away from the area.

Mr. Olmedo reported that the west approach of the State Route 7 and Maggio Road intersection was open to traffic.

Mr. Olmedo stated that the developer responsible for the roundabout improvements on State Route 86 (SR-86) and Pitzer Road has postponed the closure of SR-86 as the developer is still awaiting the Caltrans permit.

Mr. Olmedo continued that the Public Works Department would be meeting with the traffic engineer for the McCabe Road and Dogwood Road/Worthington Road and Old Highway 111 traffic signal repair project. While this project is progressing, the traffic engineer indicated that securing contractors for signal work has been challenging. Mr. Olmedo concluded his update by reporting that the power meter cabinet for the McCabe Road and Pitzer Road traffic signal is expected by the end of April.
