ADDENDUM NO. 2

July 27, 2026

This *ADDENDUM* is hereby made part of the Contract Documents and specifications to the same extent as if originally included therein and shall be signed by the Consultant and included with the proposal. Failure to sign and include this *ADDENDUM* with the proposal submission shall result in the proposal being deemed non-responsive and ineligible for consideration.

1. Proposal Due Date Extension

The proposal submission deadline, originally scheduled for July 30, 2026, at 3:00 p.m., is hereby extended to Monday, August 3, 2026, at 3:00 p.m.

2. Question: Does the County require a specific soil sampling density/depth for the ADL testing, or should the consultant propose an ADL investigation scope based on standard Caltrans protocol?

Response: Yes, the Consultant shall follow Caltrans protocol.

3. Question: Will potholing be handled under a contract amendment once utility conflicts are identified, or would the County prefer that the subconsultant include an assumed number of potholes in the proposal?

Response: Potholing shall be included as part of the proposal, in accordance with the requirements of the RFP.

4. Question: Will the Consultant need to perform full boundary surveys and prepare formal plats/legal descriptions for any required ROW acquisition or dedicated easements?

Response: A full boundary and right of way survey is expected as part of the design services. No right of way acquisition or dedication of easements is anticipated for this project.

5. Question: Is the project target completion date fixed based on grant funding deadlines?

Response: Yes

6. **Question:** Will the County provide existing aerial photogrammetry, boundary/survey control, or CAD files from previous projects in the area, or is the Consultant expected to perform a complete ground topographic survey for the project?

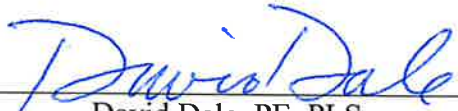
Response: The Consultant shall be responsible for providing aerial photogrammetry, surveying, and CAD files for this project. These deliverables shall be provided to the County upon completion. The County will provide available record files from previous County projects for reference.

7. **Question:** Does the County anticipate that Caltrans will review the plan submittal packages?

Response: No work will be performed within Caltrans right of way. However, the Consultant shall be responsible for obtaining the required Caltrans Temporary Traffic Control Encroachment Permit.

8. **Question:** Will the County require a geotechnical report with pavement design recommendations (R-value testing), or should consultants rely on existing County standard pavement sections for the in fill pavement and curb/gutter?

Response: The Consultant shall be responsible for preparing the geotechnical report, including pavement design recommendations as appropriate. The cost for these services shall be included in the proposal.
